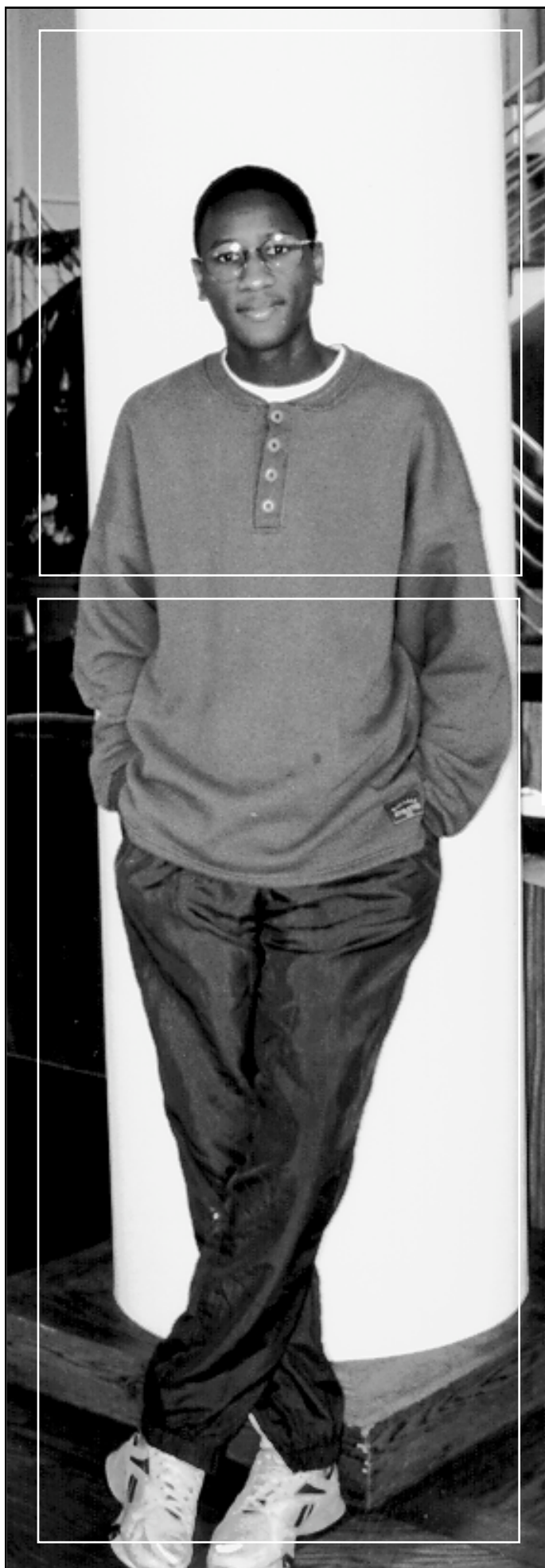

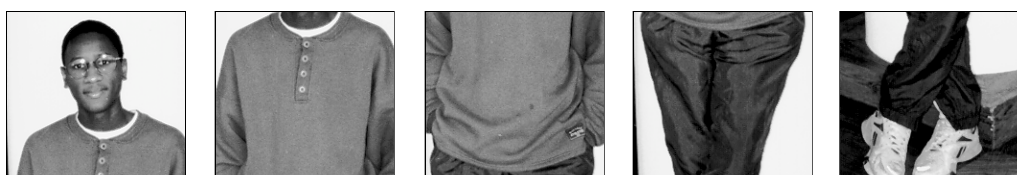
“Abou is prêt-a-porter”

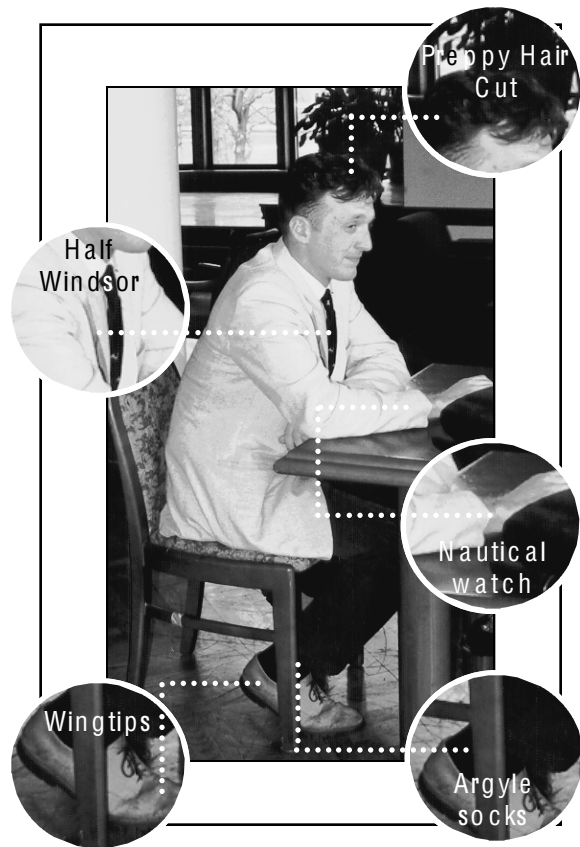

Bravo!



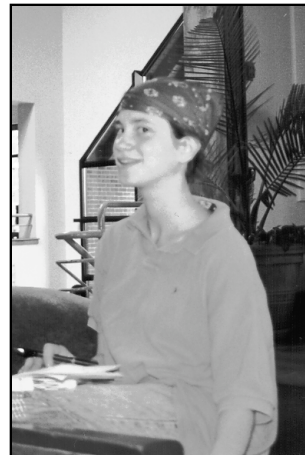

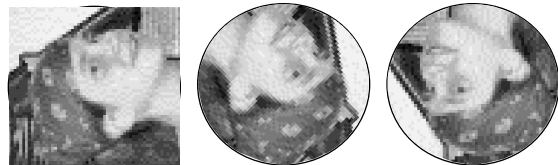
Randi Beckman
